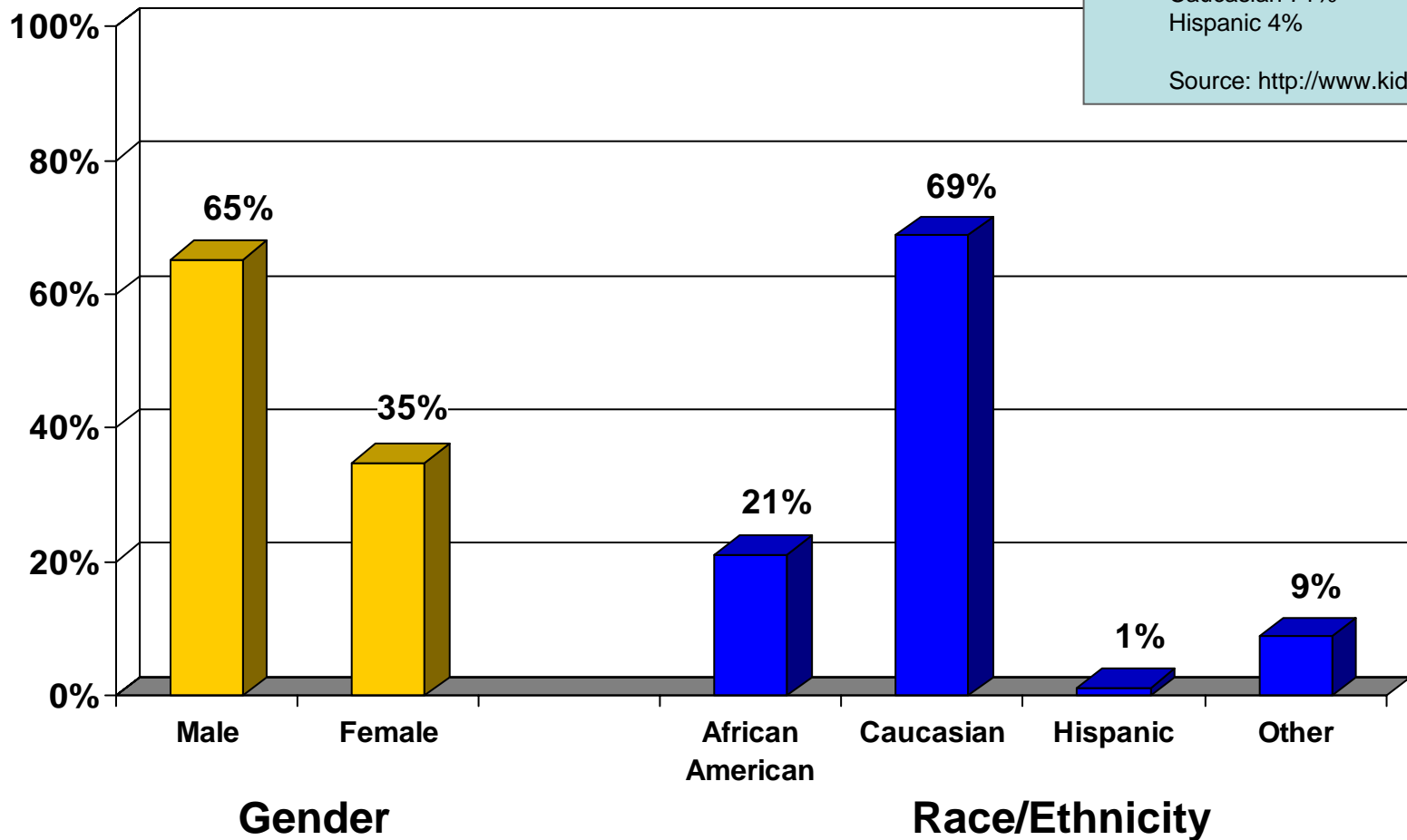

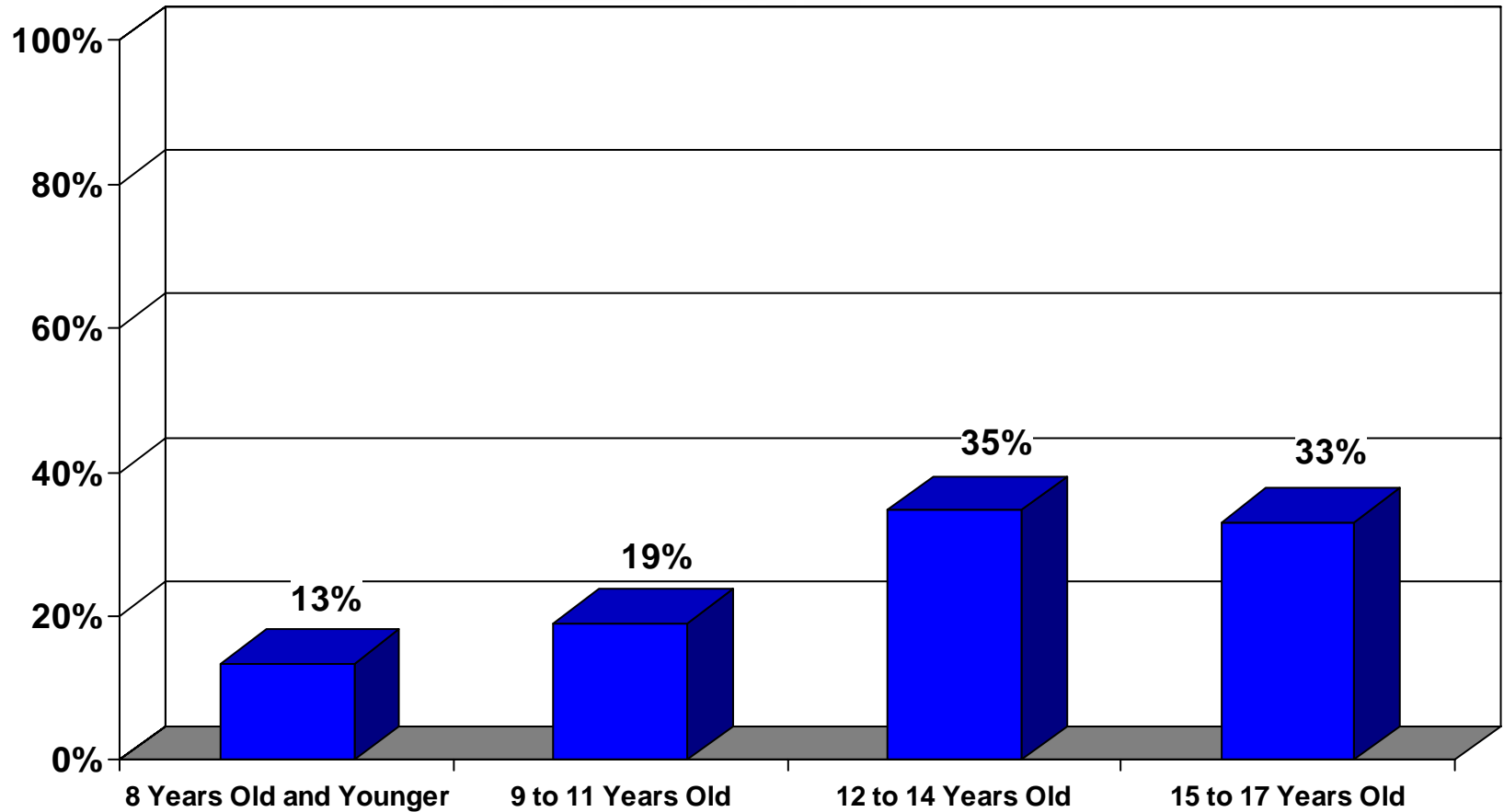

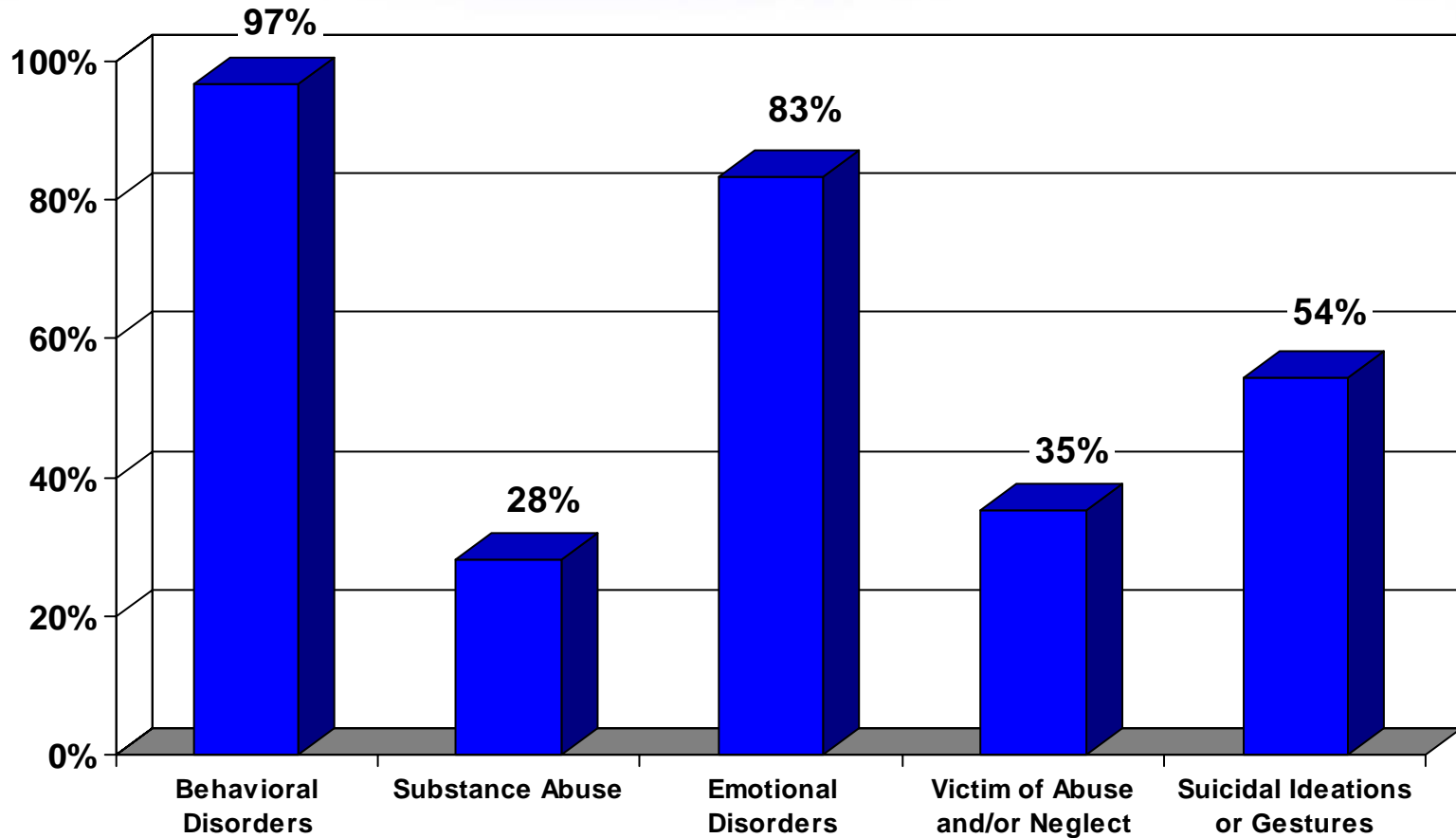

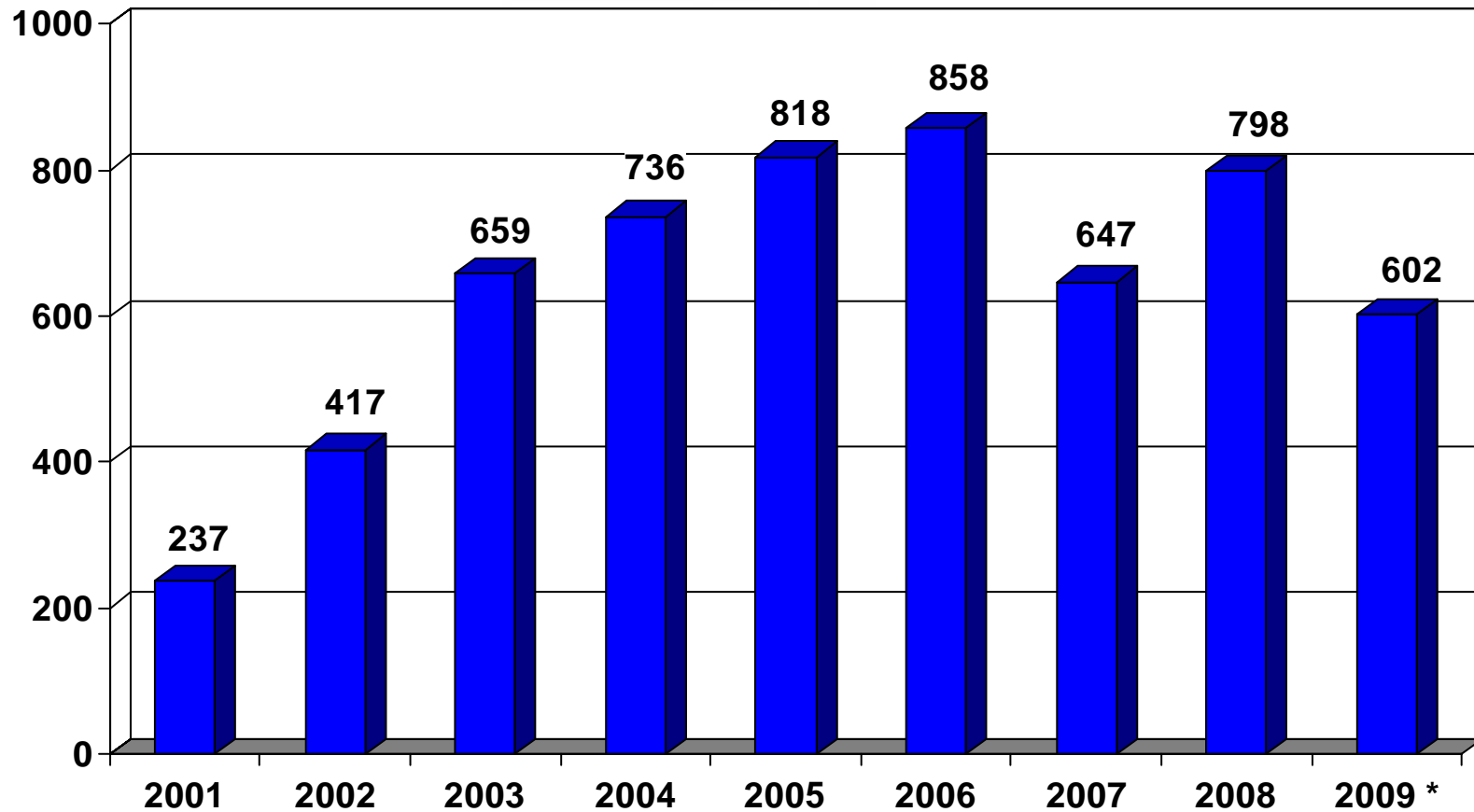
Over 93% of clients have multiple presenting issues

Fiscal Year – July 1 to June 30

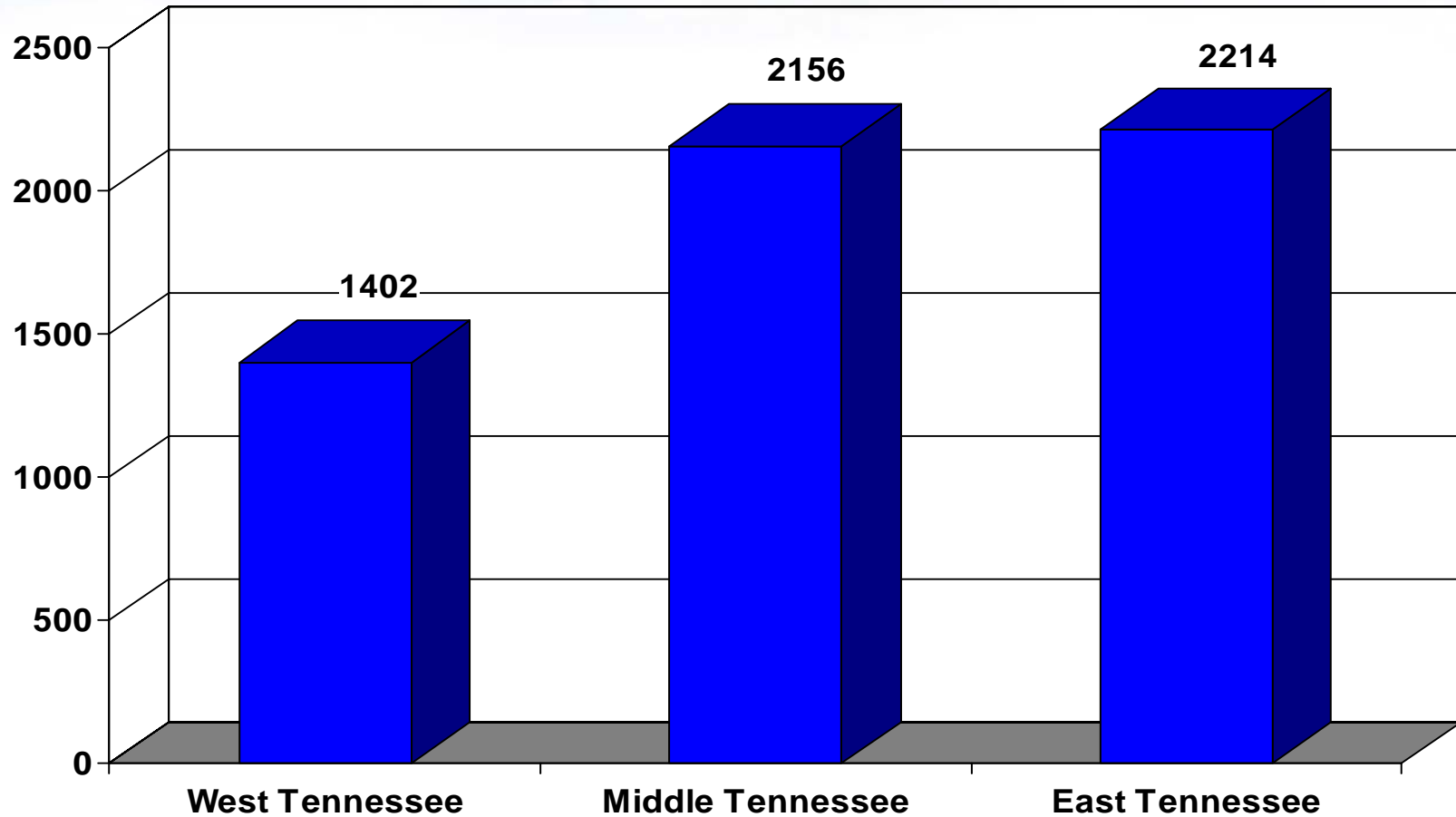

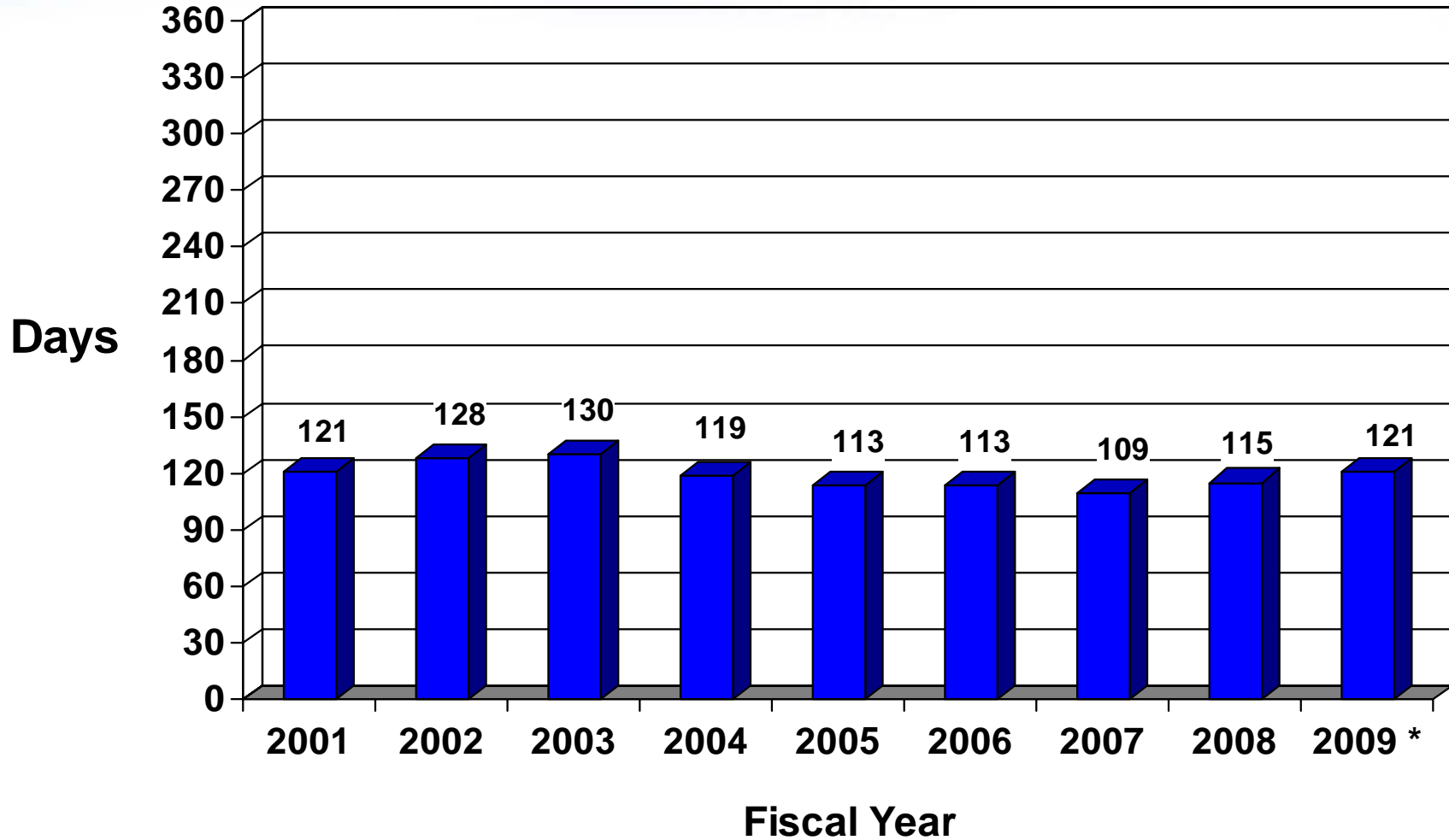

N = 5,362

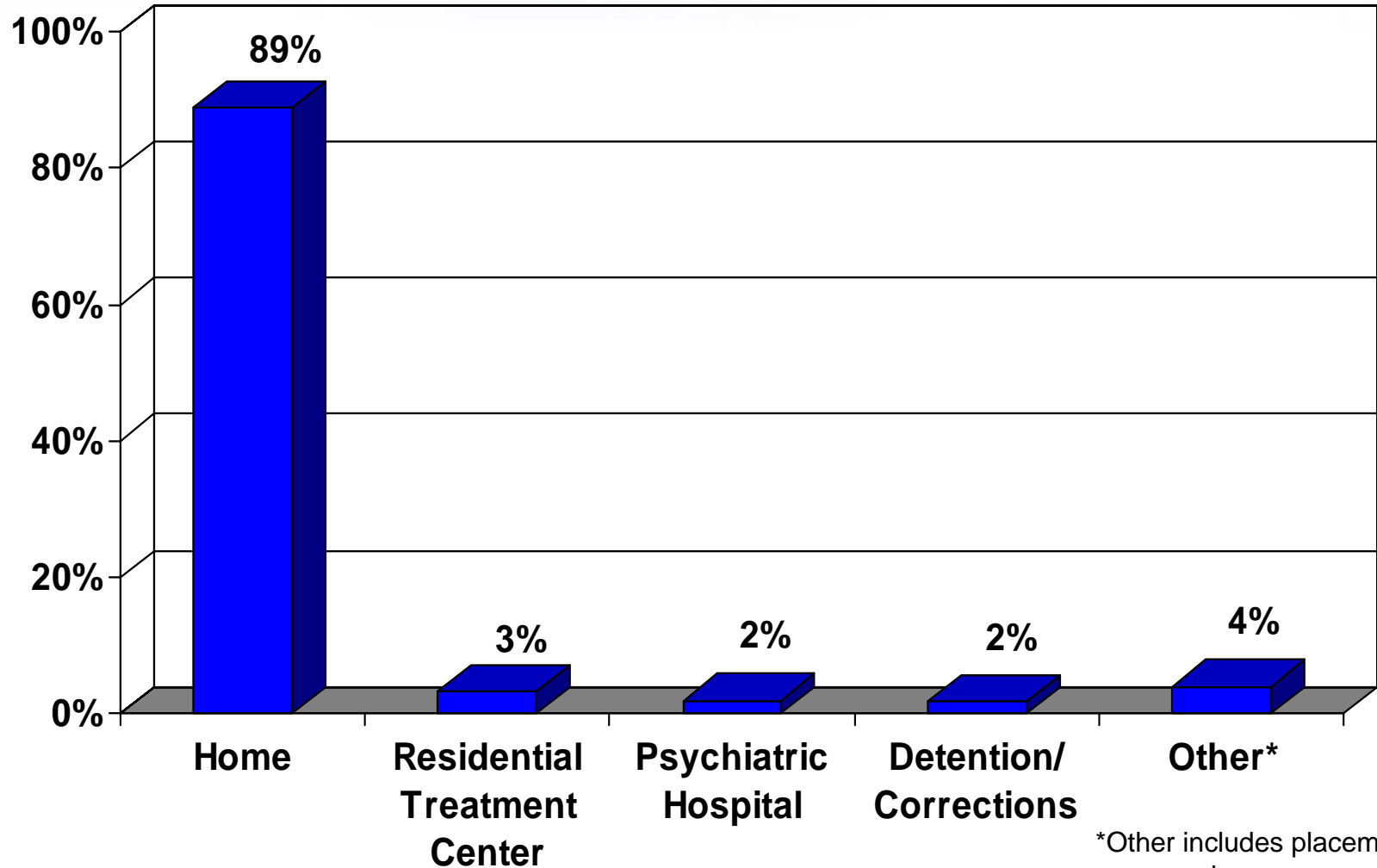


In-Home Counseling Clients

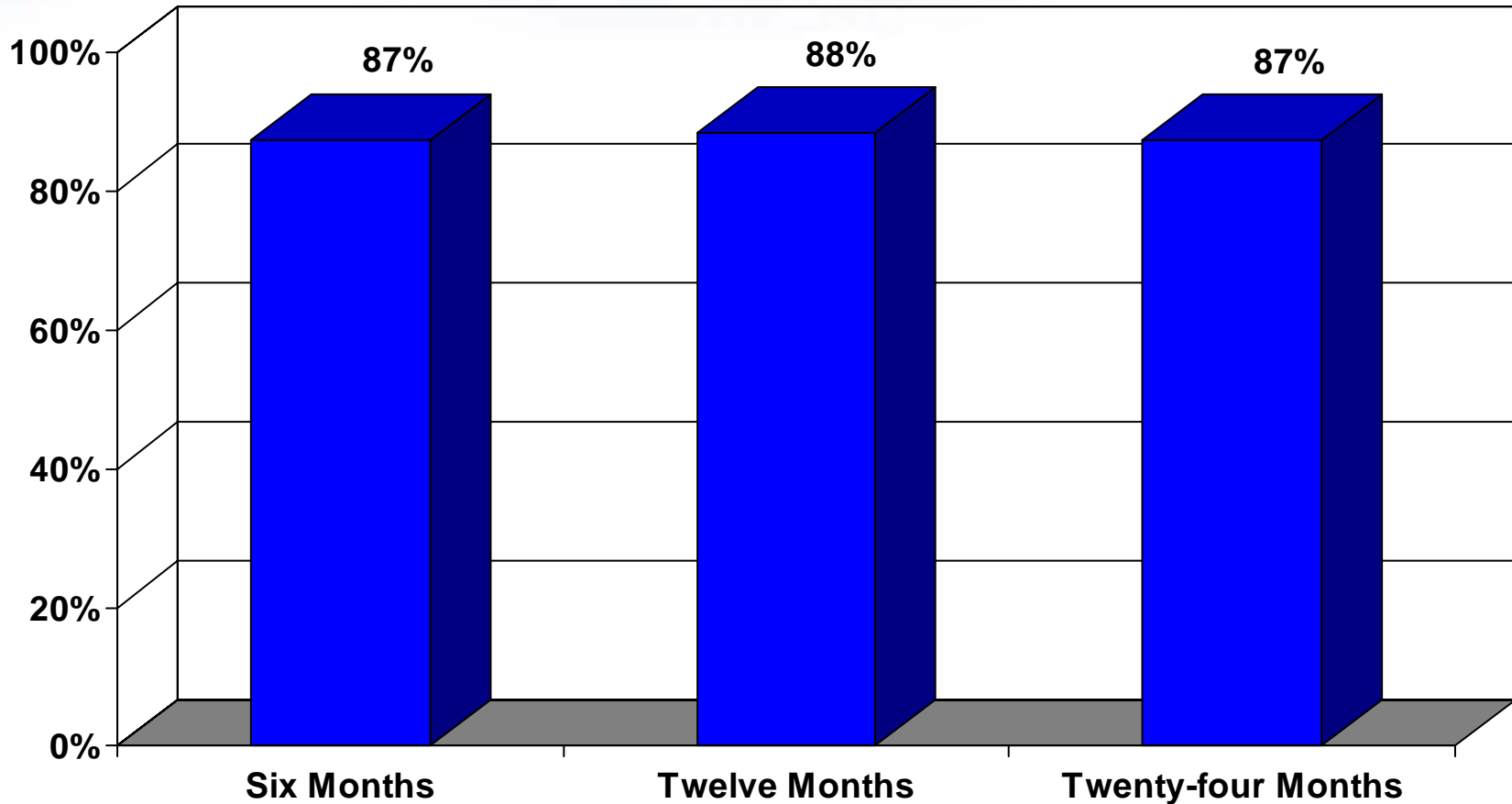

Follow-ups conducted through December 2008



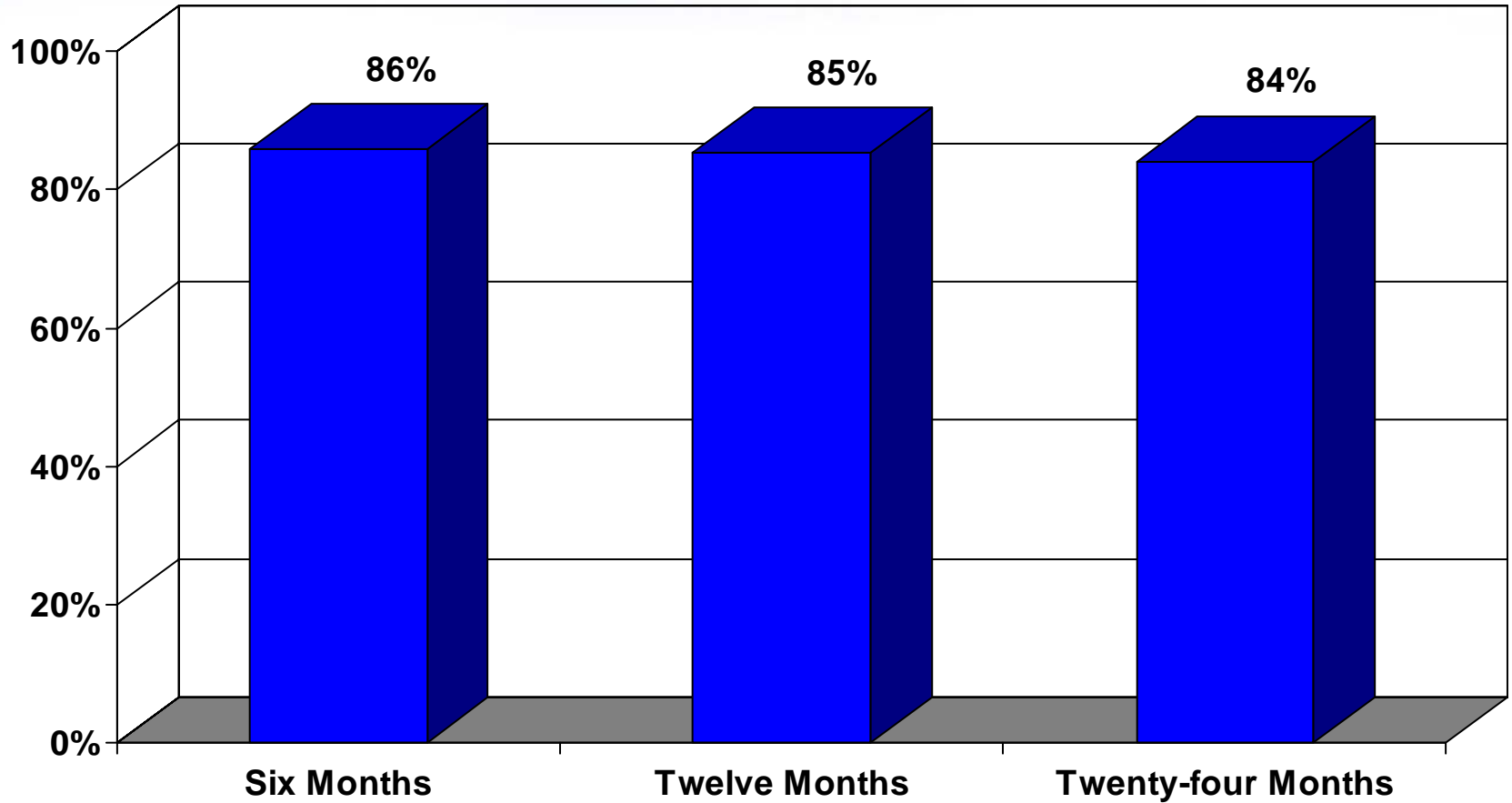

Follow-ups conducted through December 2008

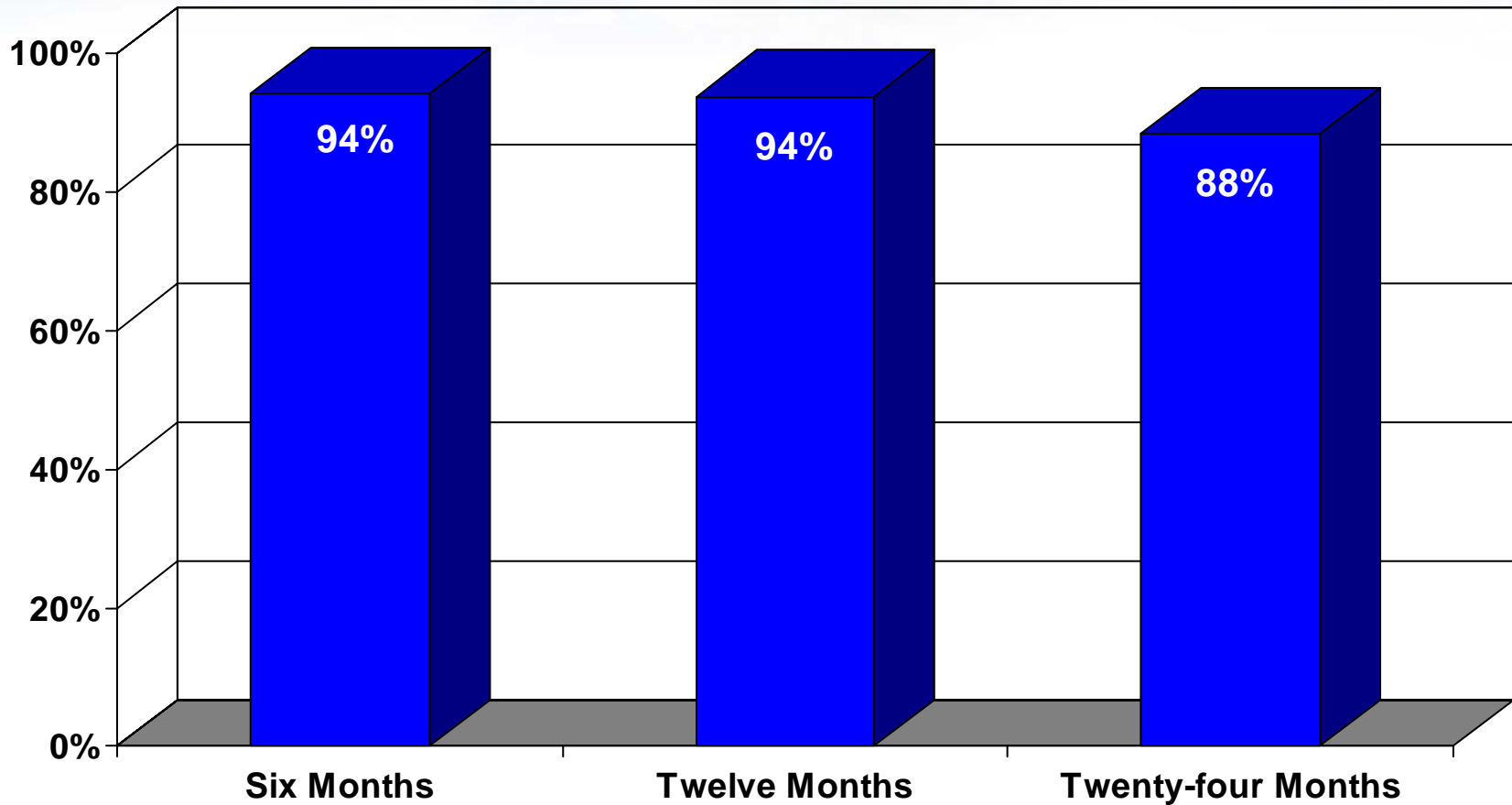

Follow-ups conducted through December 2008



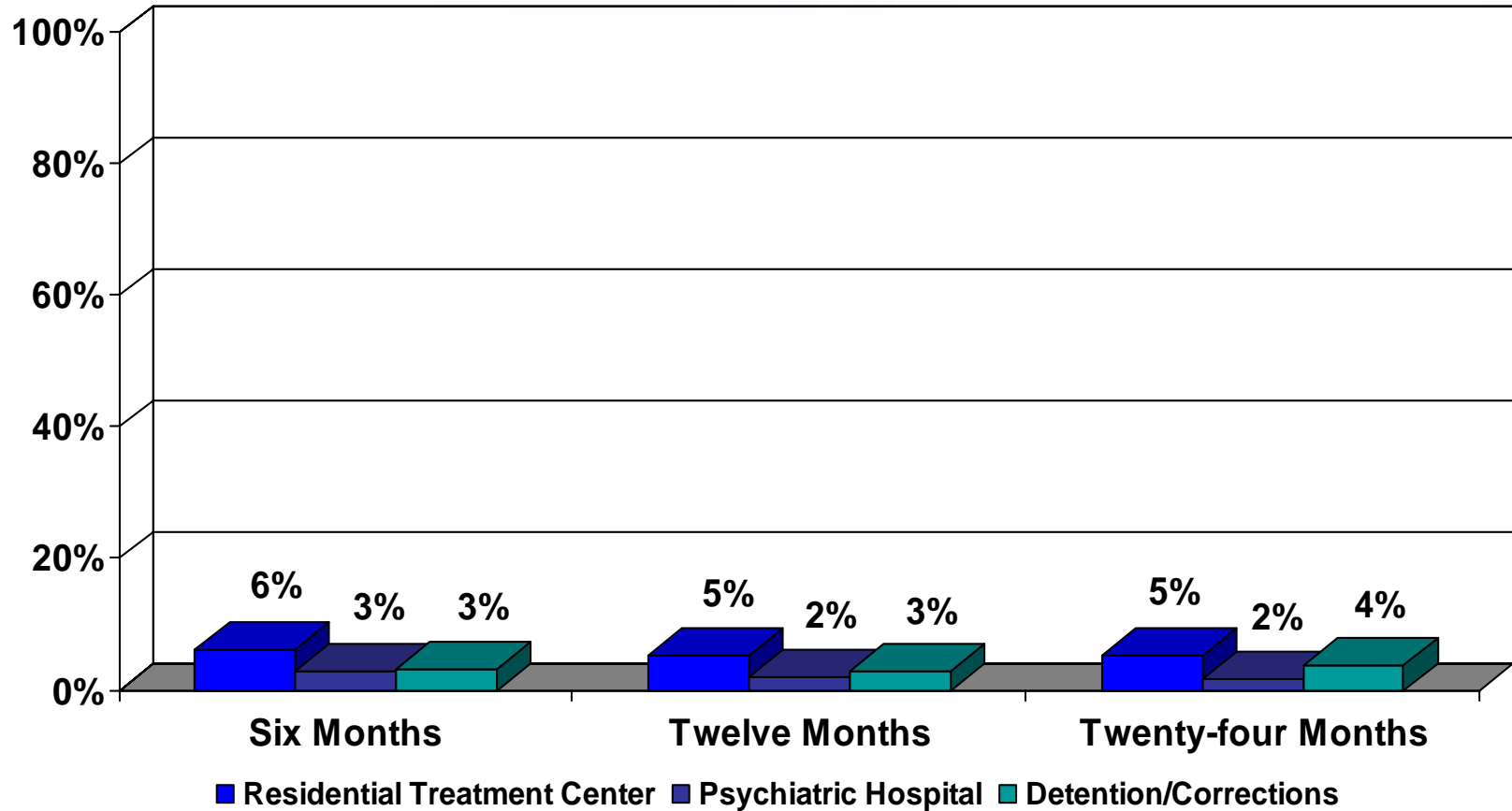

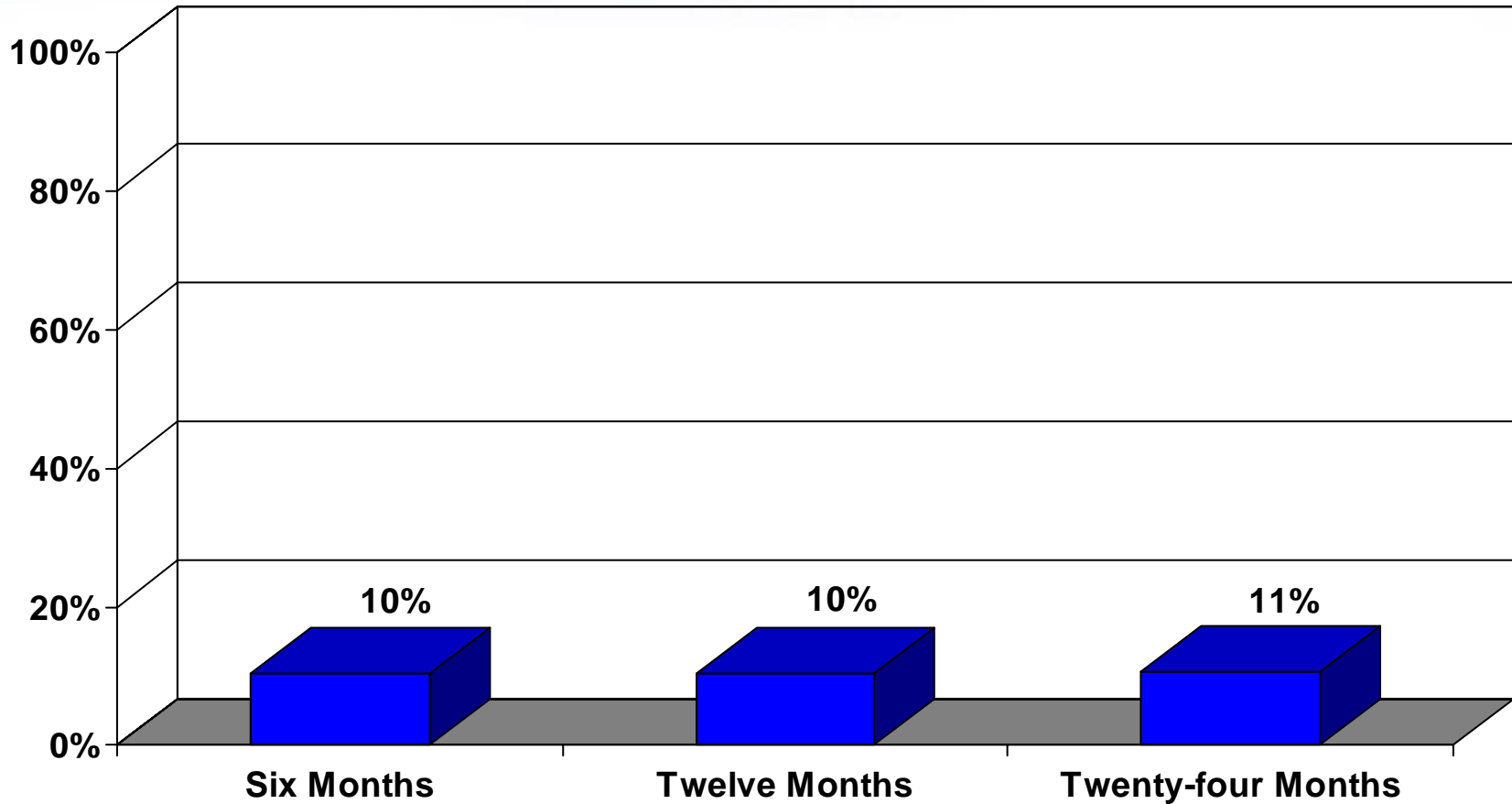
