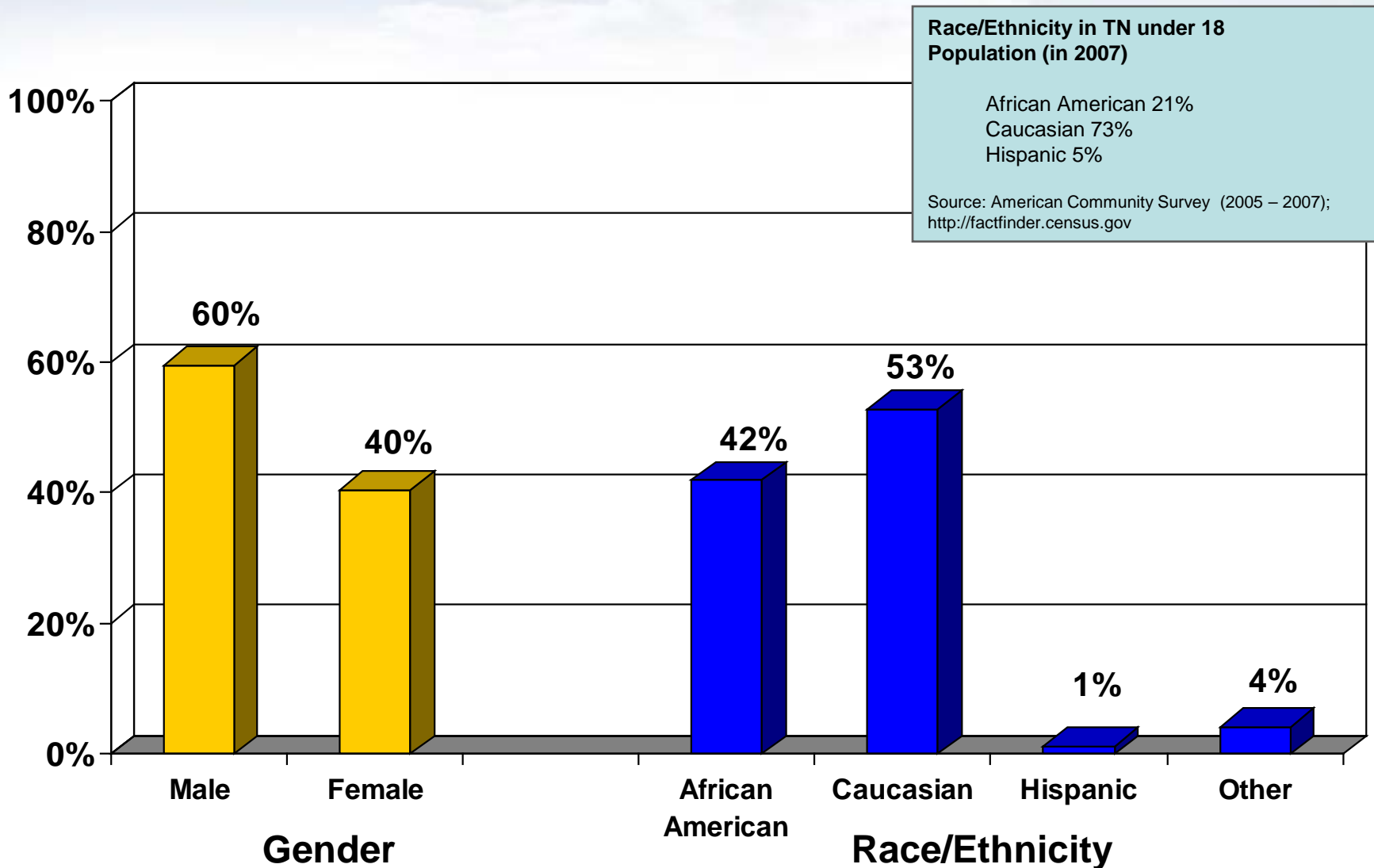

N = 4,350



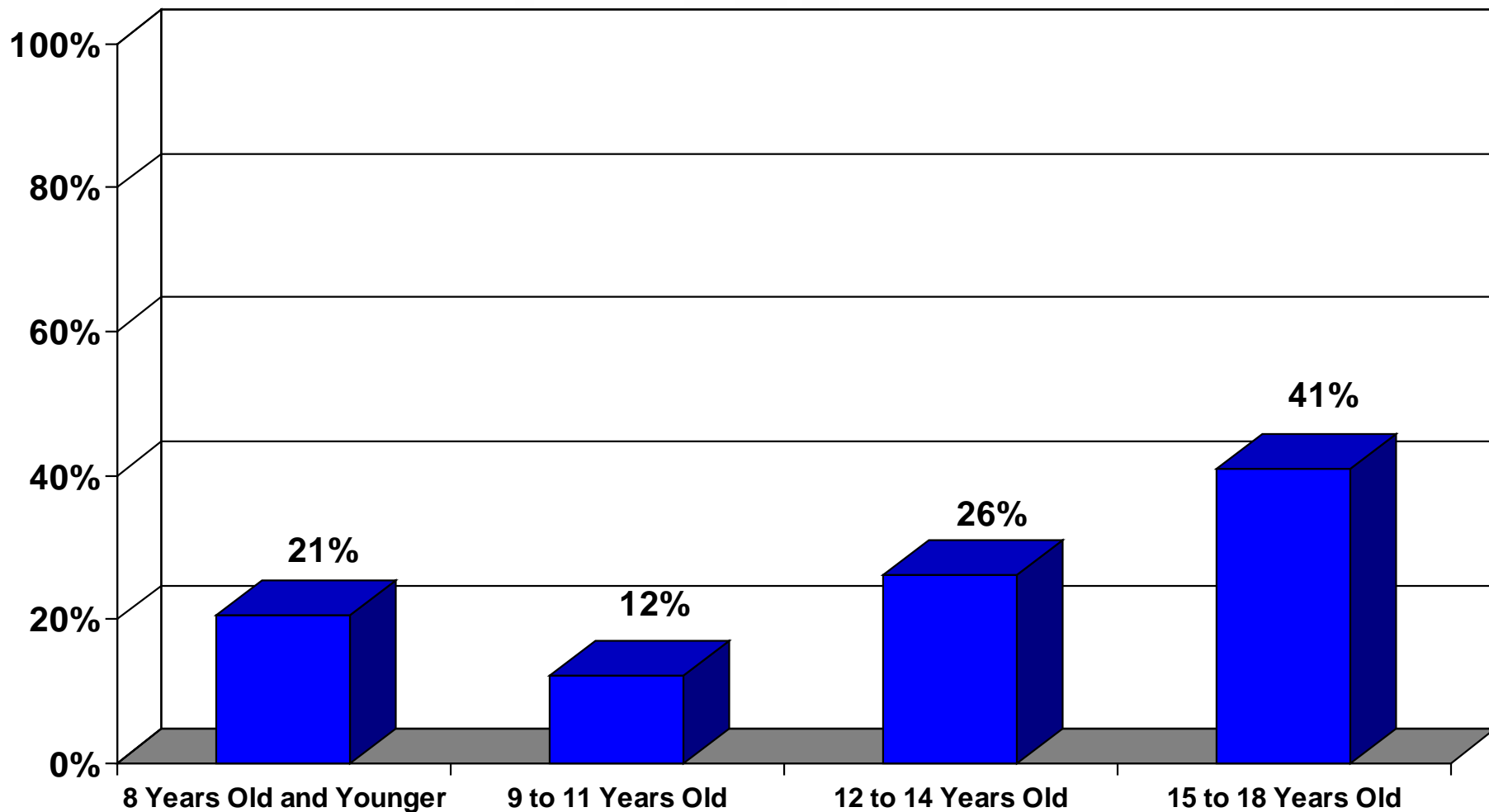

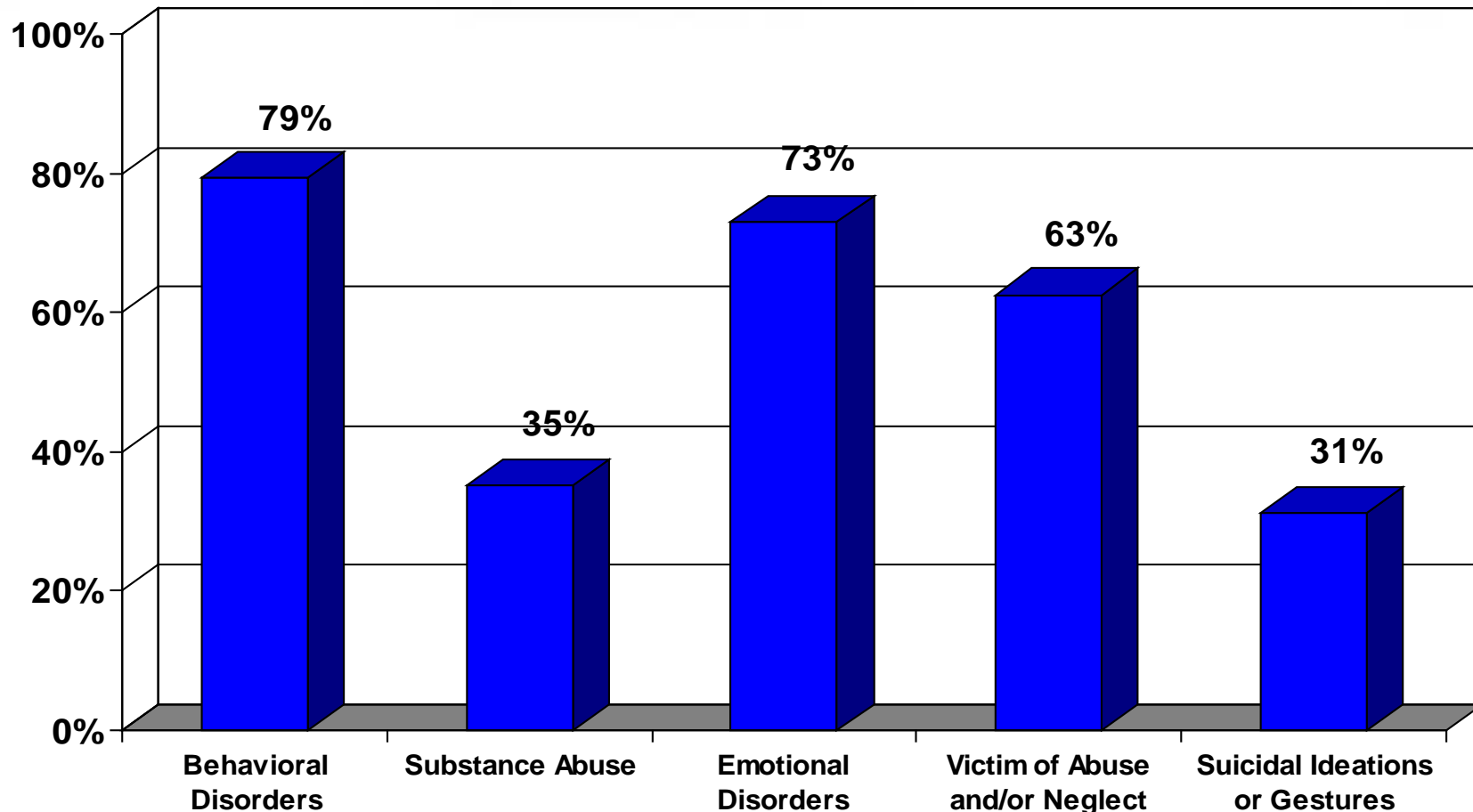

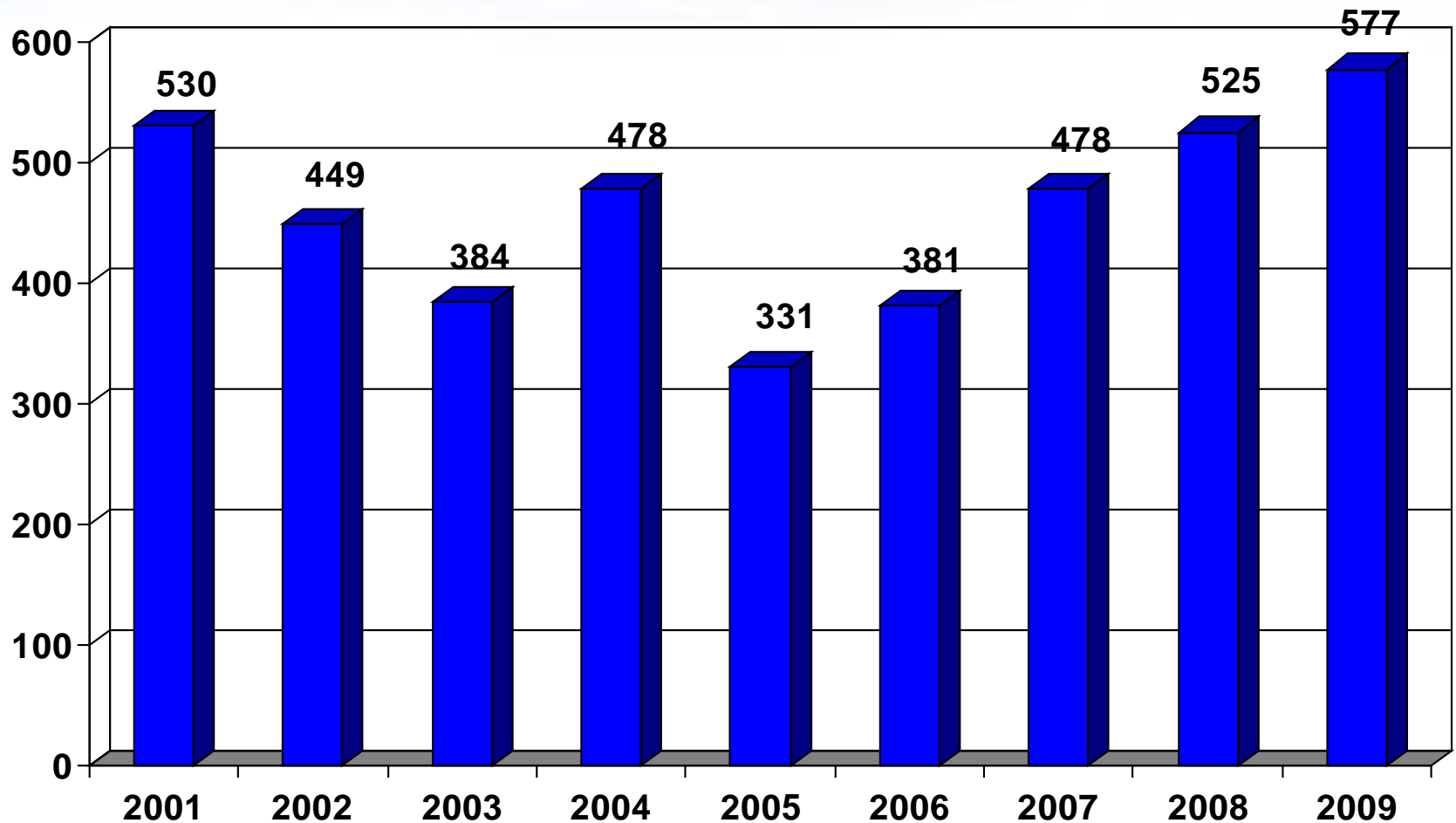
Over 80% of our youth have multiple presenting issues.

July 2000 through June 2009



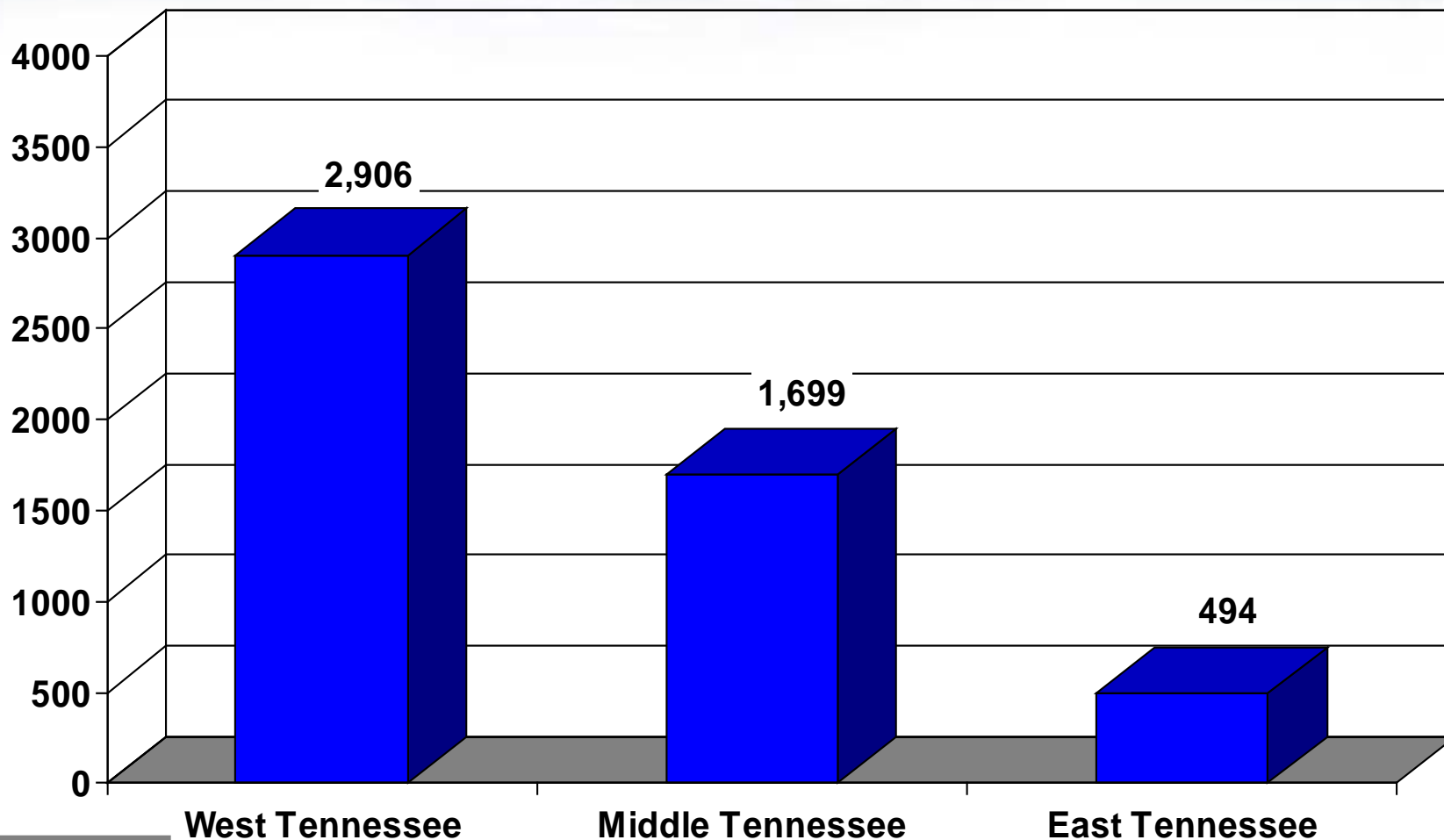
Fiscal Year – July 1 to June 30

July 2000 through June 2009

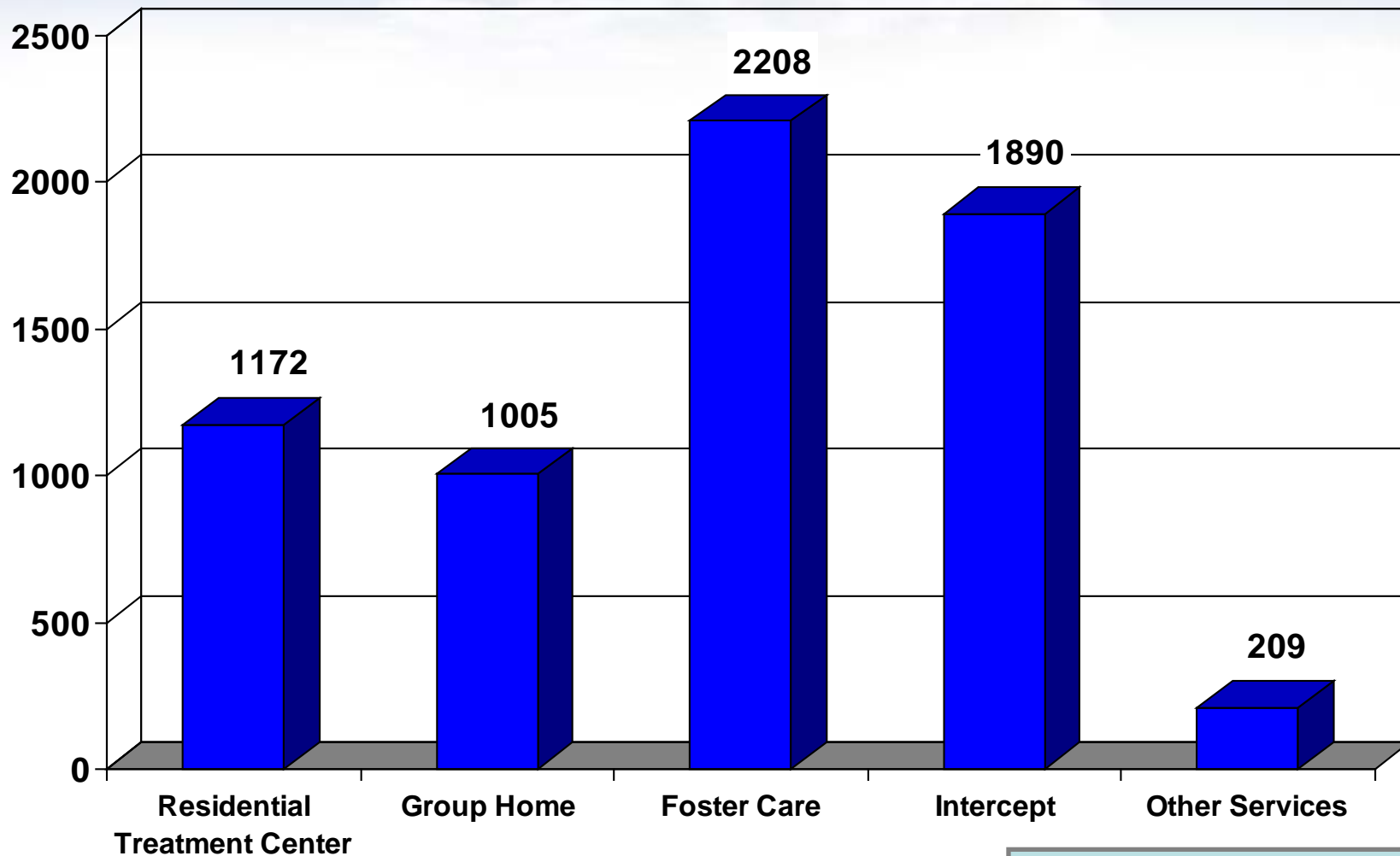


Youth may be served in multiple regions

July 2000 through June 2009



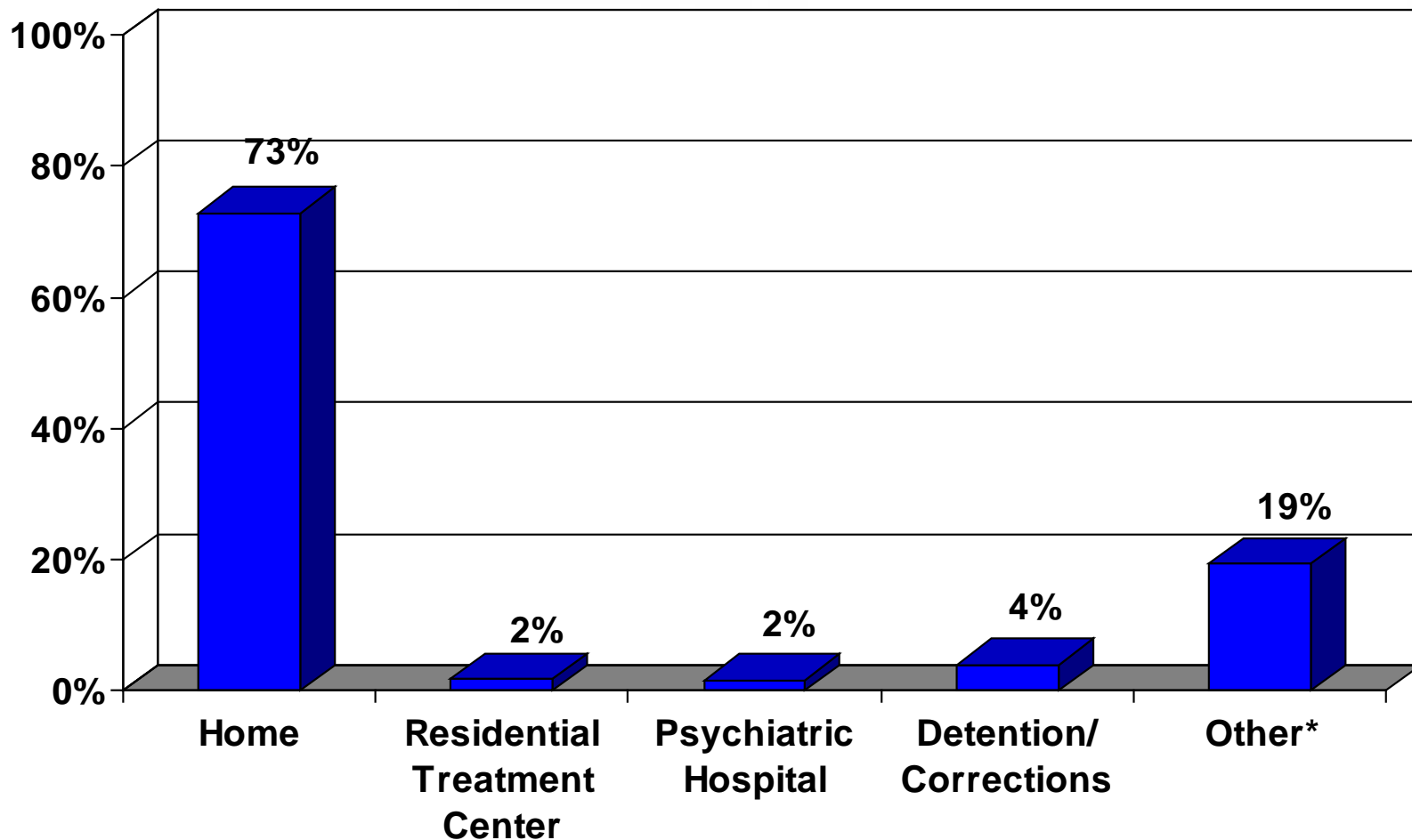
Over 55% of youth have been served in multiple programs within Youth Villages.

N = 3,509

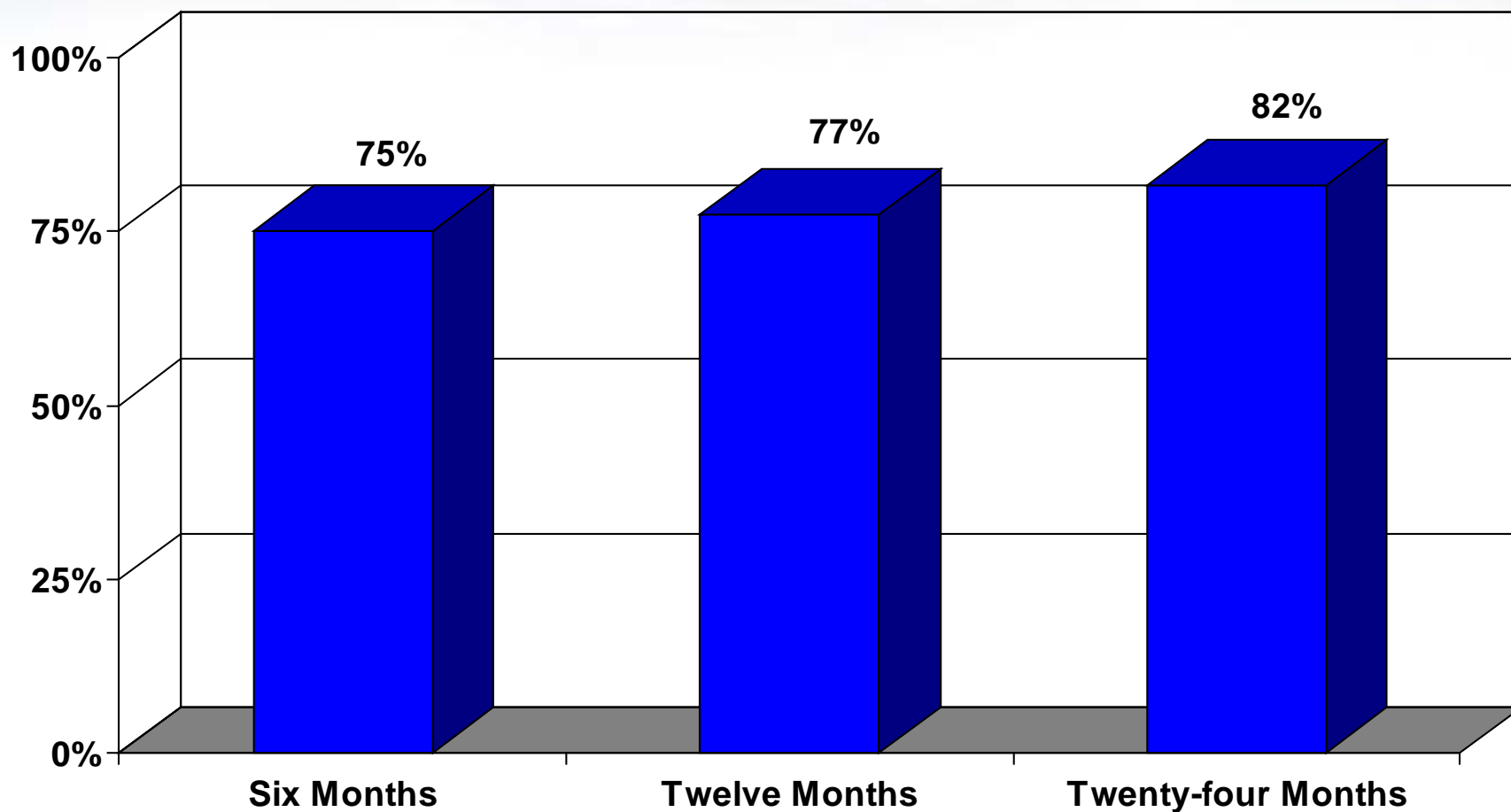

Follow-ups conducted through June 2009



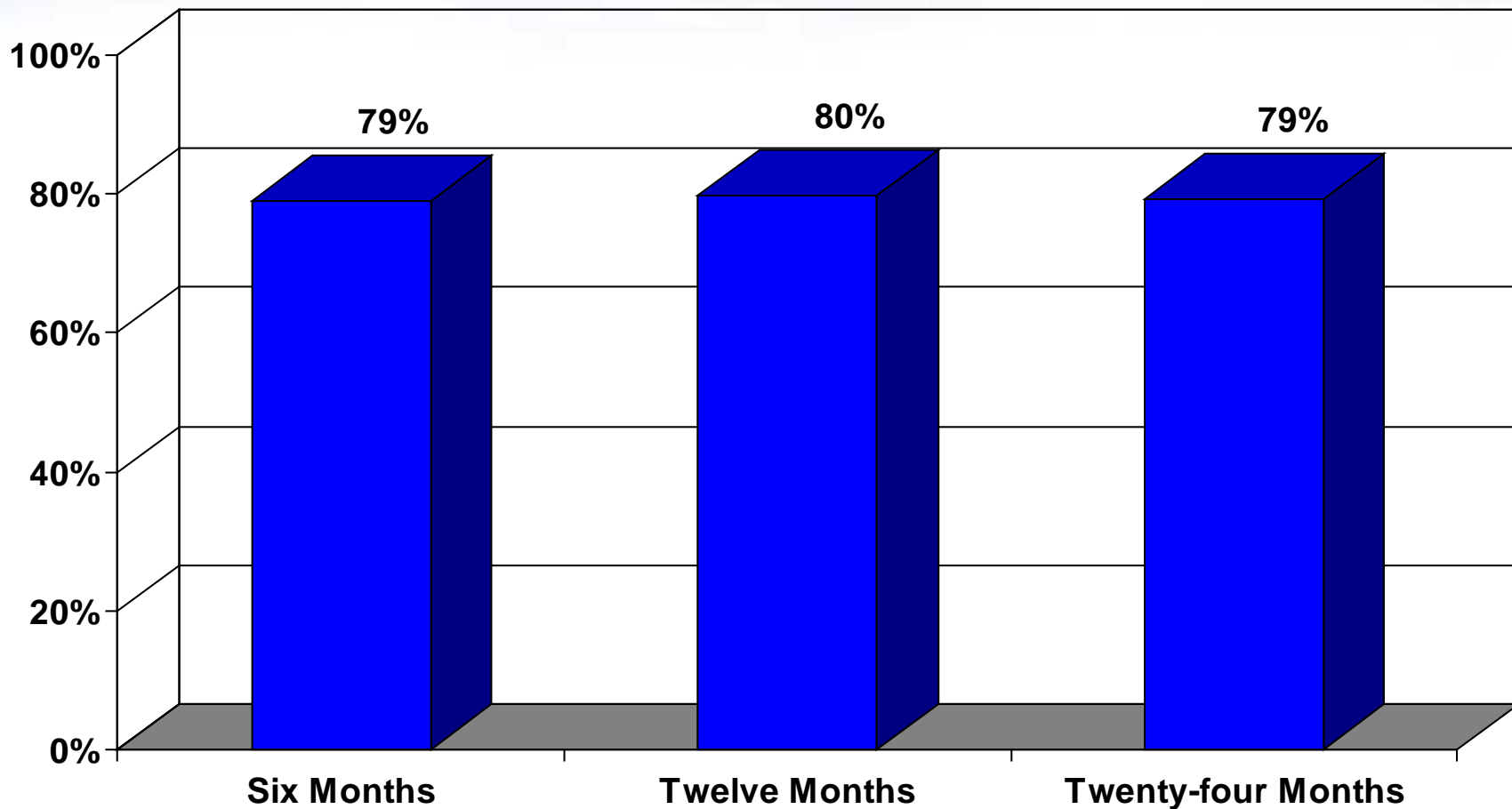
Response Rates: Six Months – 65.2% (1800 out of 2761)

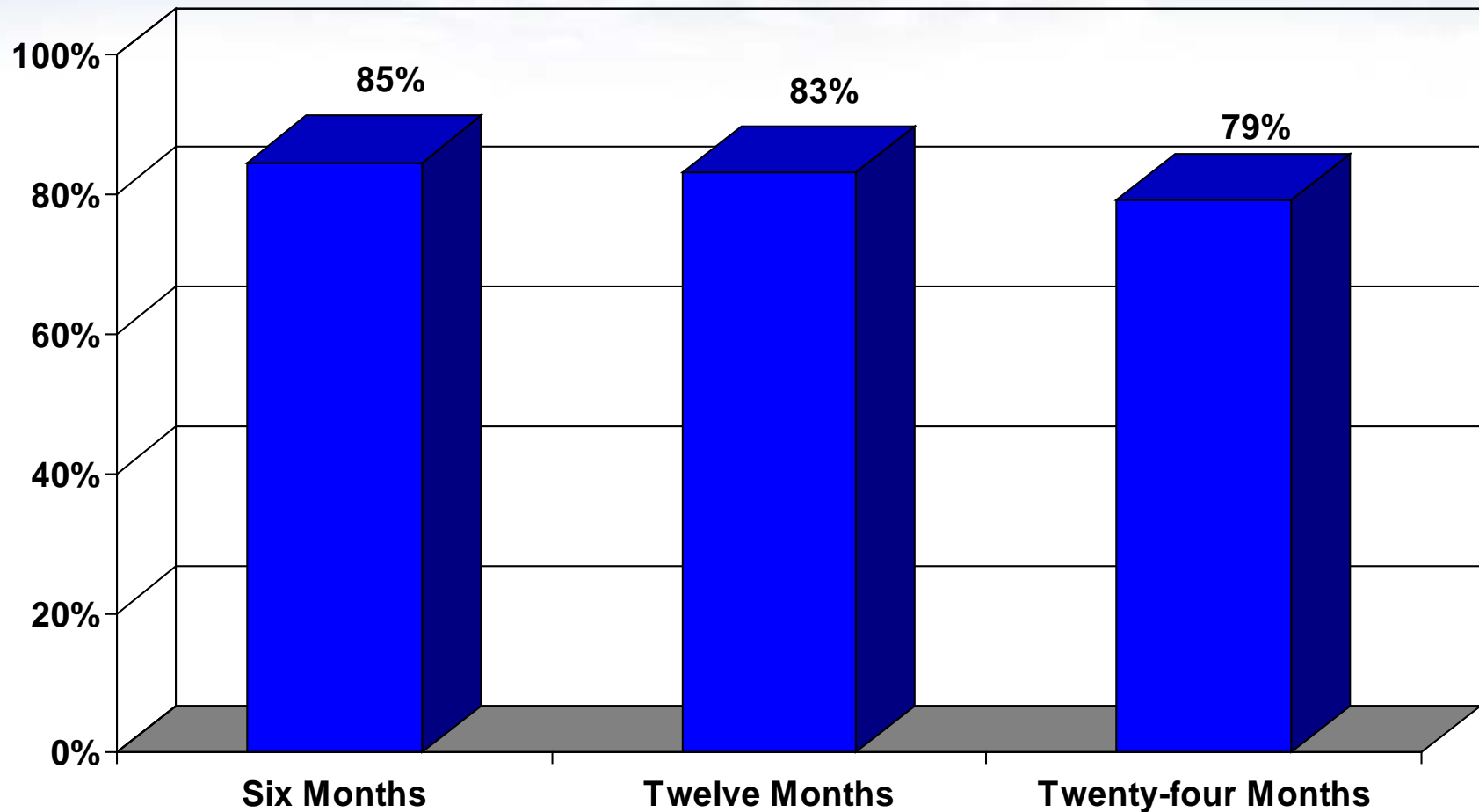

Follow-ups conducted through June 2009



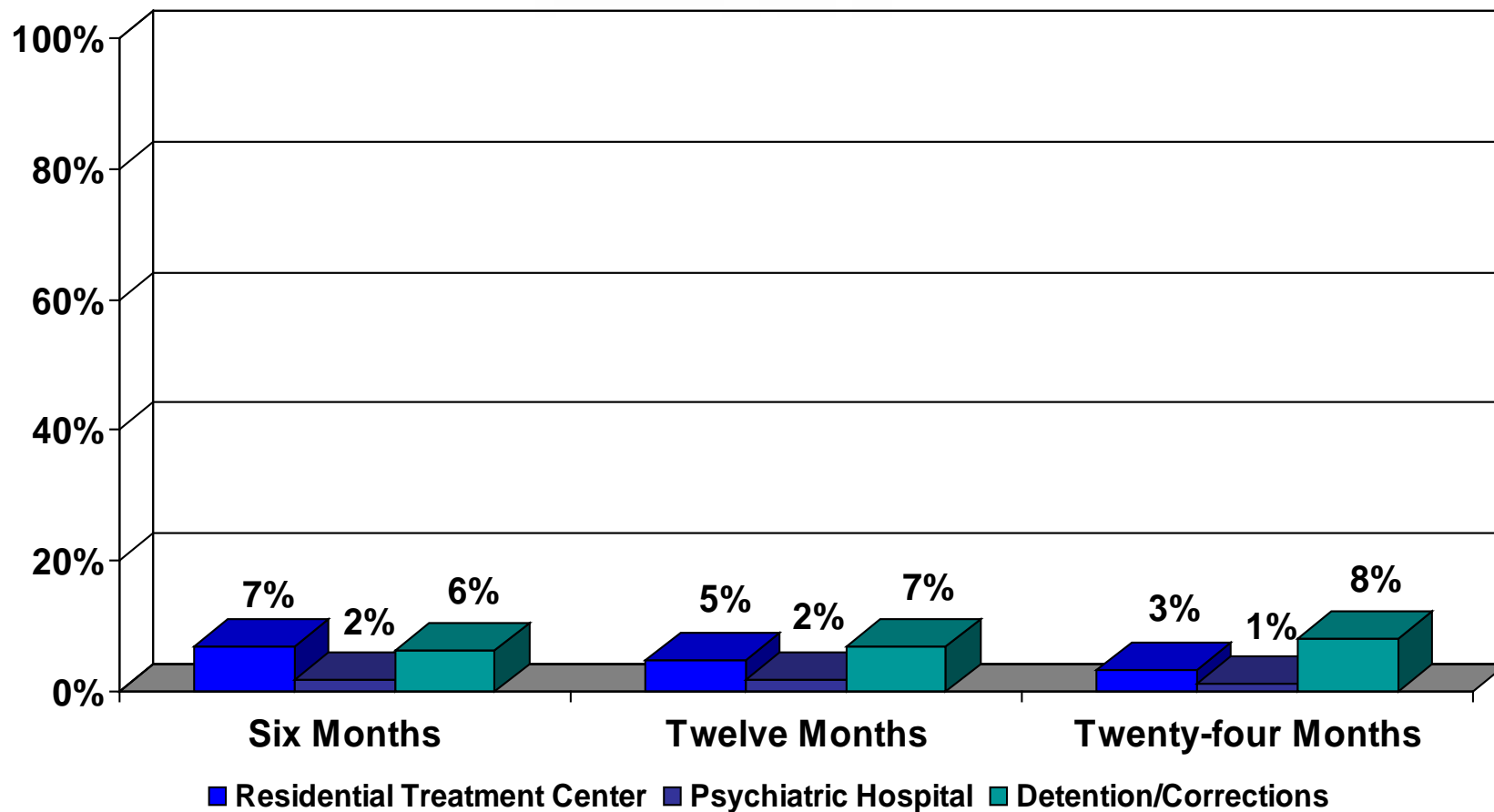
